

Hydropower Plant

Global Denim's® own Hydropower Plant is located in Orizaba, Veracruz. Next to the Rio Blanco.

Hydropower is a fully renewable, 100% clean, green energy. It consumes no natural resources, produces no emissions, and creates no waste.


Installed Capacity of 11.3 MW

It produces energy for our Mill located in San Martin, Puebla, as well for other textiles mills.

It produces the energy used for Orizaba public lighting. It is entirely committed to the local community providing them electricity whenever they need it and with better prices.

Because it is located on a touristic spot in Orizaba called "Los 500 escalones", it is committed to helping with its maintenance. Also its grounds are open to the public and is commonly used as a place for recreational activities.

It is regulated by the CRE (Energy Regulatory Commission) to meet its "clean energy" standards.



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Cogeneration Plant

Global Denim´s® own Cogeneration Plant is Located inside our Mill on San Martin, Puebla.


Cogeneration (Combined Heat and Power or CHP) is the simultaneous production of electricity and heat (steam), taking advantage of all the power capacity of natural gas.

Cogeneration offers energy savings when compared with the supply of electricity and heat from conventional power stations and boilers.

It is the most effective and efficient form of power generation.

It has lower emissions to the environment, in particular of CO2, the main greenhouse gas.

Installed capacity of 20.4 MW.



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Water Treatment Plant


Global Denim's® own Water Treatment Plant is located on San Martin, Texmelucan in Puebla.

Wastewater treatment is a process to convert wastewater, which is water no longer suitable for its most recent use, into an effluent that can be either reused for different purpuses (like irrigation) or returned to the watersupply with minimal environmental issues.

Our water treatment plant includes physical, chemical, and biological processes to remove contaminants and produce environmentally safe treated wastewater.

The physical-chemical process removes all the dyes, pigments and organic matter from the water, and regulates the pH, while the biological process cleans it.

Lastly Chlorine is added to the treated water and it is reincorporated to the water flow or used to care for green areas.



CO2 Recycling

To continue reducing our carbon footprint and helping the environment, we came out with a process to reuse and recycle our CO2.

We redirect all of the CO2 that comes out of the boilers, and from the cogeneration plant through pipes and inject it into our Water Treatment Plant, instead of letting it go freely into the environment (which produces a big amount of contamination).

This process not only helps us reduce our carbon footprint, but also helps with the biological process of water treatment, and reduces our chemical usage.



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Plastic Recycling

nside Global Denim's® Group is our own Plastic Recycling Plant, located in Lerma, Toluca in Mexico.

We recycle post-industrial and post-consumer plastic materials and produce plastic pellets, that will later turn into new products.

We also generate recycled plastic bags for supermarket and drugstore use, as well as non food safe grade plastic containers, for different companies.



Ecoloop- Cotton Recycling


Ecoloop is a Global Denim® cotton recycling program based on the creation of new fabrics with recycled cotton yarn, sourced from pre-consumer waste, PIW, our own denim floor scraps, as well as denim waste from our business partners and customers.
